I have enjoyed showing prospective parents around this week and on my tours of the school I particularly enjoyed seeing Fledgings class getting Creative with play doh and Owls class enjoying their dance lesson. I had fun joining in with a dough disco in Robins class on Monday and talking to Kingfishers class students about their class novel: Holes.

The children have all been very busy and the Autumn Term topics are already well under way. Kingfishers history topic this half term is 'How have children's lives improved?" and they will be studying the progress that has been made since the Tudor times. In Science, the Year 5/6 topic is Bright Sparks' and they will be studying light and Year 4 will be studying the classification of animals and humans. Owls history topic this half term is 'How did we learn to fly?' and they will be learning about the development of planes and influential people in flight history. In Science, they will be looking at the amazing human body including nutrition, skeletons, muscles and food chains.
