This week, I have loved visiting classes during writing lessons. We have implemented some changes to our approach to writing this year, including introducing 'ALWAYS' skills (each year group has a list of writing skills they are expected to always use e.g. finger spaces and full stops in Year 1, joined handwriting and correct use of a/an in Year 3, relative clauses in Year 6 and more!). Owls and Kingfishers are also using SPAG Ninja to practise their grammar, and we can already see that the children are embracing the new learning opportunities, well done everyone.

On Wednesday, Owls enjoyed an afternoon of discovering dragon and dinosaur eggs to inspire their independent writing based on their class text: 'The Boy who Grew Dragons' by Andy Shepherd. Robins have enjoyed identifying leaves in science and had lots of fun at Forest School this week—thanks Alex! As Scientists, Kingfishers Class have been comparing reversible and irreversible changes and the impact heat has on these. Clubs started this week, and it was great to see so many children taking part!

Later this month, we would like to invite parents into classrooms for a family learning session. You are invited to join in with a normal lesson with your child. We plan to host these sessions termly and will ensure they are held on different days—we hope this will give parents the opportunity to join us at some point over the year.
