We have enjoyed the sunshine this week and there has been lots of learning in the natural environment including Forest School, PE lessons, assembly, making potions and mud pies in the new playground kitchen, science lessons and even some Maths and Writing! Robins have been observing and identifying parts of plants in science this week as well as checking on the beans they are growing. Kingfishers have been studying the buildings the Anglo Saxons created and how these have progressed from the Iron Age. Owls have impressed us with their letter writing to Andy Shepherd, the author of our book: The Boy Who Grew Dragons. We hope he replies to our letters!

At Halwin, we know just how important reading is and we love hearing about children's reading at home, as well as their special book nooks, favourite books and authors and visits to the library. Children in Owls and Kingfishers, using the Accelerated Reader programme have already read a total of 240,615 words since the start of term and children learning RWI phonics in Robins and Owls have been gaining team points for every home read ticked off in their RWI pink reading records. Well done.

I will be running a parent workshop about Accelerated Reader next Tuesday after school for parents of children in Y2 to Y6 and Mrs Tamblin will be running an EYFS and Y1 parents workshop about RWI phonics on Tuesday 8th October —we hope you can all join us.

Owls and Kingfishers now all have their logins for our new spelling online platform: Spelling Shed . They have been assigned this week's spelling and can practice them using the online games.

You will have received an email this week regarding signing up for Autumn Term clubs. We will confirm your club choices next week and clubs will commence w/c 30th September.
